



Initially, the apartment was a typical "Euro-double" with finishing by the builder. "When thinking about the design concept of the future interior, I decided to proceed from the peculiarities of the layout. The dining room, living room, and hallway are combined into one open space. The lower part of the wall and the kitchen cabinet were painted in one color according to the NCS system, which helped to visually unite the zones. The walls were painted in dusty shades of blue and lilac, adding dynamics to the interior. The idea came spontaneously: I really wanted to dilute the white color with bright elements. The result surpassed all expectations!"

The bedroom is decorated with gray-brown wallpaper with a complex geometric pattern. In addition to the seating area, the designer has provided a compact workspace in the room. The wall above the desk is lined with relief panels that resonate with the decoration of the kitchen fronts. Also the color of the pouffe and bedside table is repeated on the carpet in the living room, linking the interior into a single whole.




